

Roxton ISD Names Lone Finalist



On March 5, the Roxton ISD Board of Trustees voted to name Trevor Rogers as lone finalist for the position of superintendent/CEO. He has served public education 19 years, most recently as high school principal at Harleton ISD. Rogers began his career as teacher/coach at Paris ISD and continued as teacher/coach at Whitehouse ISD, University of Mary Hardin-Baylor, Palestine ISD and Jacksonville ISD. During his time at Jacksonville ISD he also served as assistant high school principal from 2002 to 2005. Rogers moved to Angleton in 2005 to take the position of high school assistant principal. He then moved to Grand Saline and served as principal from 2006-2007. The Board of Trustees is scheduled to vote to hire the end of March.
