



## Notice of Candidate Filing Period for May 4, 2019 Election<sup>1</sup>

The first deadline for the May 4, 2019 election is **Monday, December 17, 2018**: the deadline to post notice of candidate filing period under Texas Election Code section 141.040.

The Secretary of State Elections Division provides the [Notice of Deadline to File Applications for Place on the Ballot](#) form in English and Spanish on its website.

In its Election Law Calendar, the Elections Division addresses the posting of the Notice:

The authority with whom an application for a place on the ballot is filed must post a Notice of Deadline to File Applications for Place on the Ballot, listing the filing period dates in a building in which the authority maintains an office. The notice must be posted not later than the 30th day **before** the first day to file. (Sec. 141.040). If you order a special election to fill a vacancy, the order must include the filing deadline; we recommend posting the notice of the filing period as soon as practicable after a special election is ordered.

TASB Legal Services recommends posting the Notice in the location a district regularly uses for posting public notices, including the school district's website if it maintains a website.

In completing the *Notice of Deadline to File Applications for Place on the Ballot* for the May 4, 2019 regular trustee election, TASB Legal Services also recommends the following:

- Include the district name, the election type (i.e., Regular School Board Trustee Election), and the election date of May 4, 2019, in the title of the Notice.
- Insert the *Start Date*, the first day to file for a place on the ballot: **Wednesday January 16, 2019**
- Insert the *End Date*, the last day to file for a place on the ballot: **Friday, February 15, 2019, at 5:00 p.m.**
- Insert in *Office Hours* the dates and times the school district will be open during this period.
- Insert the physical address and mailing address for filing an application.
- *Optional*: An application for a place on the ballot is available at the \_\_\_\_\_ ISD offices at \_\_\_\_\_ (address).

- *Optional if your district posts election information on its website:* The application and additional election information is also available online at \_\_\_\_\_.
- Include the printed and signed name of the filing officer and the date posted.
