Moises L. Alfaro is a current board member of the Mathis I.S.D. currently beginning his 2nd four-year term. He is a former educator having taught in the Pasadena I.S.D. (1997-1998) and Mathis I.S.D. as an elementary bilingual education teacher (1998-2004). Moises has also served as an assistant principal and principal of Mathis Intermediate School and associate principal for the Mathis High School for International Studies School (2004-2012). Currently he works as an HSE (Health, Safety, and Environmental) Manager for Wood Group PSN, an oil field maintenance and construction company in Kenedy, Texas.
